**Inspector General Reopens Investigation of Improper Access and
Dissemination of Personal Information Contained Within a Secret Service
Database**

The Department of Homeland Security Inspector General has reopened its investigation into allegations that one or more Secret Service agents improperly accessed internal databases to look up the employment application of an individual who later became a Member of Congress. The investigation was reopened as a result of Secret Service Director Joseph Clancy announcing that he now has a different recollection of the events in question than that he conveyed to Office of Inspector General investigators during his interview on July 17, 2015.

The Office of Inspector General will conduct further interviews and take other investigative steps, as appropriate, and issue a public addendum to the September 25, 2015 report.
